

2023 ANNUAL ELECTION REPORT

MONASH UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS SERVICE

1. Introduction

Monash University International Students Service (MUISS) is a division of the Monash University Student Association (MSA). Under the agreement between MSA and OGL Group (OGL), OGL is responsible for conducting the Annual Elections for the MSA and its divisions, including for MUISS.

Jessica Fox was the Returning Officer for the 2023 MUISS Election and is the author of this report.

This report sets out the process by which the elections were undertaken, specifically highlighting areas that required attention by the Returning Officer and electoral participants. An overview of the results is provided, emphasising trends and other observations.

The key issues and other areas of concern experienced in the election are discussed. Finally, a set of recommendations are provided to MUISS as suggestions by which the electoral process can be improved.

2. Process

Pursuant to the MSA Regulations, notice was given on 4 September that Annual Elections would be held from Monday 18 September to Wednesday 20 September 2023 (see **Appendix 1 – Notice of Election**). The Notice of the Election was published on the MUISS Election webpage. An email was sent to all eligible students via Global Connect advising students of the election on 4 September (see **Appendix 2 – Email to Students – Notice of Election**).

Nominations for all positions were due at 5:00 pm Friday 8 September. Nomination forms and all other election paperwork were submitted via email at these elections. Students could also complete a Google Form to submit their nomination.

Candidate nominations

Nominations were opened at 9:00 am on Monday 4 September and closed at 5:00 pm on Friday 8 September. The final notice of nominations received was posted on Wednesday 20 September (see **Appendix 3 – Notice of Nominations Received**).

After the closing of nominations, a detailed verification process was undertaken to ensure that candidates and their nominators and seconders were eligible to participate in the election by virtue of their enrolment status as well as the international student status of nominators and seconder, as provided for in the Regulations. During this process, all nominations were found to be eligible, with all nominated students eligible to stand for election.

At the close of the nomination period:

- 9 valid nominations were received
- > 1 ticket was registered
- The positions of Activities Officer, Education Officer, President, Publications Officer and General Secretary were declared elected unopposed. There were two contested positions

Tickets

Candidates running as a group were stipulated to appoint an Authorising Officer and register their ticket name with the Returning Officer before the close of nominations at 5pm on Friday 8th September. One group did so and this is also listed in **Appendix 3 – Notice of Nominations Received.**

Voting

Voting was delayed due to an incomplete roll being provided by the University and was rescheduled to take place from Monday 25 September and Wednesday 27 September. This was communicated to all nominees via email and was also posted on the MUISS Election webpage.

Polling took place on the BigPulse voting platform. To cast their vote, eligible voters needed click an individual ballot link emailed to their official university email address and follow the prompts to submit their vote.

Eligibility to vote was restricted to Monash Clayton international undergraduate students as per the Election Regulations and MSA Constitution.

The following table summarises the times during which students cast their votes, with the majority of voting taking place the day of the opening of polls. A reminder email was sent to students who hadn't voted yet at 9:00 am on Wednesday 27 September.

3. Results

Declarations

Results were declared on Wednesday 27 September, with results then immediately being sent to all candidates via email. The Notice of Results was also published on the MUISS Election website (see **Appendix 4 – Notice of Results**).

Participation

The 2023 election recorded a smaller number of students voting compared to last year's recent contested elections, with 311 voters casting their votes through the polling period, representing approximately 2.6% of the eligible student population. This is in comparison with 682 voters and 820 voters in the 2022 and 2021 Annual Elections, respectively.

Appeals/Recounts

No appeals or recount requests were received.

4. Issues

There are several inconsistencies present the latest version of the MUISS Election Regulations which are routinely worked around in the election process (such as referring to a mandatory Notice as per Schedule 1, where no Schedule 1 exists). This governing document has not kept pace with changes in other MSA documents with which it works in tandem, in particular the MSA Election Regulations.

Recommendation 1:

That MUISS review their Election Regulations as a whole, drafting such amendments as necessary to ensure that these Regulations are complete and without inconsistency and error, and to ensure consistency and accuracy with the stipulations set down in the MSA Election Regulations and Consitution.

5. Conclusion
