To be eligible to vote or run for a position on the MAPS committee, you must be:

- 23 years old or over; or
- Enrolled in 12 or fewer credit points; or
- Attending Monash University, Clayton via distance education

Nominations

Nominations are now open for:

- President (1 to be elected)
- Vice President (1 to be elected)
- Treasurer/Secretary (1 to be elected)
- Social Secretary (1 to be elected)

Please note, you may nominate for, but cannot hold, multiple positions. If elected to a position, your nomination for all other positions will be withdrawn. The order of election is as above.

Nominations will be closed during the AGM. You may nominate in absentia, meaning that you are not required to attend the AGM.

All nominations require a nominator and seconder who are both eligible members of MAPS.

Election

If there is more than one nomination for a position, a secret ballot will be conducted.

Candidates will be given an opportunity to speak for 1 minute in support of their election. If you are unable to attend the AGM, you may instead provide a statement via the nomination form which will be read on your behalf.
